

Admissions Process

Thank you for your interest in Killian Hill Christian School (KHCS)! We hope you'll find the detailed steps below a helpful guide during the admission process.

- 1. Tour** - We are delighted to show you around our campus! Your first step is to schedule a [tour](#).
- 2. Application** - All admission applications are submitted online. Kindergarten applicants should be 5 by September 1st. Based on limited openings each year, date of application can affect opportunity for admission.
- 3. Assessment / Academic Records / Shadow Day**
 - Students are cognitively and educationally assessed for success at KHCS. This testing will be scheduled through the admission office.
 - Official copies of the applicant's academic records are required. This should include the first semester of 2015-2016. Report cards, transcripts, standardized testing, any previous academic testing, discipline report and current immunization records are required.
 - Each student 3rd-11th is encouraged to "shadow" with their grade at KHCS. This on-campus experience is beneficial for applicants and KHCS!
- 4. Parent Interview** - A formal interview with both parents and the student will be scheduled with the Departmental Principal. The interview will serve as an opportunity for the Departmental Principal to share key components of the KHCS philosophy, evaluate the educational objectives of the family and acquaint themselves with the parents and student in order to make an informed admissions decision. The interview will also allow the parents to evaluate the philosophy, objectives and offerings of KHCS to determine best fit for their student. The interview lasts approximately 1 ½ hours.
- 5. Decision** - Upon full completion of the above process and final evaluation by the admission team, the family will be notified of the admission decision. Official acceptance is based on admission test scores, transcript review, personal interview results and availability of enrollment space. Killian Hill Christian School admits students of any race, color and national or ethnic origin.
